Doctors and Dentists

The Springbank Surgery provides a full medical primary care service to local patients led by GPs and nursing staff. The Advanced Nurse Practitioner at the surgery provides services such as initial assessment (triage), treatment of minor conditions and advice and care for patients with long term conditions such as diabetes. The surgery has two consulting rooms and one treatment room available for primary care services. Opening hours are 8.30am to 6.30pm. Many of the services available during this time are Nurse Practitioner led. A dental surgery offers a full dental service and local people and patients of the surgery can come into the centre and register.

Nursery

Giggles Nursery is a family run setting which offers care for children from 3 months to 5 year olds. Morning or afternoon sessions are also available. The nursery opens Monday to Friday from 8am to 6pm and is open 50 weeks of the year. Funded places are available for 3 and 4 year olds and all employer childcare

vouchers are accepted. Places are limited to 38 at any one time so please phone 01242 574511 or email info@giggles-nursery.co.uk to reserve a place or to arrange a viewing.

First4Skills
